

Lifelong Montclair resident Eliza Huber-Weiss has a passion for international service. Last summer, she traveled to the village of Lerai, Tanzania, and helped build houses there; before that trip, she lived in the Satluj River Valley in India's Western Himalayas and taught English. But Huber-Weiss' most significant achievement is the creation of Africa Initiative, a club that links students with peers in the South African village of Lillydale. She, her twin sister and father came up with the idea of a scanned and e-mailed monthly letter exchange. Fundraisers supply the students with sports equipment and educational posters, and the correspondence creates a personal connection. "I think what's most resonant is how similar people at my school find their pen pals to be," she says. Huber-Weiss hopes to return to Lillydale someday, and says that "Community service has become a really important part of my life."
